## ART of ROCK and ROLL



Call for original art depicting music that has made an impact on you. Use your imagination to create your favorite musical visualizations.

### SUBJECT CONTENT

Create your own imaginative artwork! You may consider these suggested topics for subject content based on your perception of creating original artwork:

- Think about the broad spectrum of music and your favorite song or musical artist in order to create an original album cover featuring this favorite personal choice.
- Create a visualization of a powerful moment in history impacted by music.
- Choose any appropriate song that inspires you to create original artwork and reflects your source of inspiration.
- Choose your favorite album artwork and recreate it in your own way.
- Depict a musical singer or group whose lyrics you admire.
- Show how a musician or multiple musicians impacted you in original artwork.
- Create a depiction of emotions impacting you by your favorite rock and roll song.
- Display favorite musical instruments.
- Portray favorite musical venues.

- Students in grades K - 12 throughout 15 counties of Texas Education Service Center Region 6 are eligible.
- The Bush Library retains the right to use entries. One entry per student per contest.
- Artwork must be screened by school teachers or homeschool parents.

## FORMAT

- 2-D Artwork can be any media matted for standard frame sizes with the outer edge of the matte being: 11x14in. (min.), 16x20in., and 24x36in. (max.). Recommended sizes for canvas: 11x14in. (min.), 16x20in., 18x24in. and 24x36in. (max.).
- 3-D artwork can be any media and no larger than 24 x 24 x 24 in.
- For students in grade K – 6, either individual or team artwork is accepted. Team size is no more than 10 students per entry. For students in grade 7 – 12, only individual artwork will be accepted.

## AWARDS

First place gift certificates given per grade based on individual artwork:

- Grades K – 2: \$50 gift certificate
- Grades 3 – 5: \$50 gift certificate
- Grades 6 – 8: \$75 gift certificate
- Grades 9 – 12: \$100 gift certificate

First place team artwork: \$20 gift certificate per student.  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place and honorable mention trophies for each grade category.
